

Partner Express Item Descriptors and What They Mean

Food distributed from Food Bank of the Rockies comes in various pack sizes and amounts. When placing your order on Partner Express, make sure to check the Unit of Measurement (what you are ordering) and the Pack size (what you will find inside) of each item so you are ordering the right amount. Below is a table of descriptors that you may see, and what they mean:

UOM	What it Means
Case	Box containing individual units
Bag	No set quantity of items inside
Pallet	Fully packed pallet with multiple cases
Bundle	Product wrapped or tied together

Pack Size	What it Means
Various	No set amount
Bulk	Loose contents
Assorted	Random/Misc Items
OZ, Count, LBS, etc.	Examples below

What's a Gaylord?

- A full pallet of loose product
- UOM will always say "PALLET"
- "GAYLORD" will be in the description column
- Picture for reference (2 gaylords shown)

Remember to look at the **Gross Weight** of each item! This will help you gauge just exactly how large your order may be! Gross Weight is listed as LBS. and is measured by a single unit (UOM) of the item.
